

Rosedale Park Disc Golf Course

Disc golf, also known as frisbee golf, is played like traditional golf. However, instead of hitting a ball with a club, players throw a disc from a tee pad to a metal basket. The aim of the game is to complete each hole in the fewest throws possible. The player with the lowest score wins.

Disc golf

- General** – Disc golf is played on a course with 9 holes. Each time the disc is thrown, the player's score increases by 1. The lowest score wins.
- Tee throws** – The first throw from the tee pad is called a tee throw.
- Lie** – the spot where the disc lands.
- Par** – like ball golf, each hole has a par.
- Fairway throw** – the throw from the lie to the basket.
- Throwing order** – the order in which the disc is thrown.
- After teeing off** – after the tee throw, the player must throw the disc from the lie to the basket.
- Putting** – within 10 feet of the basket, the player is attempting to throw the disc into the basket.
- Completion of hole** – once the disc is in the basket, the hole is complete.
- Park courtesy** – please be respectful of other players.
- Take home your disc** – please do not leave your disc on the course.
