OFFICIAL DISC GOLF RULES

Lie - where the disc stops after the throw constitutes the player's lie.
Tee throw - initial throw on each hole must be made from the tee area.
Fairway throw - all throws after the tee throw, players front foot must be touching the player's lie, at the time of release (a run up is allowed).
Putt throw - within 10m of the basket a player may not touch any point in front of player's lie before, during or after throw.
 (This means no falling putts).
Unplayable lie - (1 stroke penalty) - an unplayable lie is any disc stuck into a hazard (e.g. tree or bush). Next throw must be made from below or behind unplayable lie, not closer to the hole.
Disc furthest from the hole throws first
Low score on preceding hole throws first.

LOCAL GREEN RULES

Penalty stroke occur when:

Any disc is retrieved from the pond/swamp to be thrown
 (no penalty if thrown from lie in pond/swamp)

Any disc lands 2m or higher in a tree or bush

Fairway throw - all throws after the tee throw, players front foot must be touching the player's lie, at the time of release (a run up is allowed).

N.B. The park is for the pleasure of all park users. Please do not damage plant life. If you have to enter the pond/swamp, please be careful. Be courteous to other people using the park. If a basket is unplayable due to other park users, please select an alternative basket.

Never throw if there is a chance someone may get hit
